Ladies and Gentlemen,

If you register for our seminar "YMLA 2026" on 12/13 June 2026 in Hamburg (hereinafter referred to as the "**Event**"), we, the German Maritime Law Association (Deutscher Verein für Internationales Seerecht e. V. "DVIS"), will process your personal data.

Since we take data protection very seriously, we will inform you below about the type, scope and purpose of the processing of your personal data in connection with the Event.

In any case, we treat such information confidentially and in accordance with the statutory provisions. We process your personal data in connection with participation in the Event as the person responsible within the meaning of Art. 4 No. 7 GDPR and guarantee compliance with the statutory provisions, in particular the legality of the data processing carried out.

### Your Rights

You have the right

- to object to the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR;
- to obtain information about your personal data processed by us in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR;
- to request the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and, if necessary, to have incomplete data concerning you completed pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR;
- to request that personal data concerning you are erased immediately where one of the grounds listed in Art. 17 GDPR applies;
- to request a restriction of processing where one of the grounds listed in Art. 18 GDPR applies;
- in accordance with Art. 20 GDPR to receive personal data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to request the transmission of this data to a third party and
- in accordance with Art. 7 (3) GDPR to withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data towards us at any time. Consequently, we will not continue processing your data, which we had done on the basis of your consent, in the future. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the legality of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until your withdrawal.

In addition, pursuant to Art. 77 GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

### Collection and storage of personal data

- fax number, e-mail-address and
- further information that you provide to us upon registration or in connection with your participation in the Event.

During the event photographs may be taken for use or on behalf of the DVIS.

### Purpose of data processing

The collection of the aforementioned data is carried out

- to be able to register you as a participant at the Event;
- to manage your registration (e.g. to create a participant list for internal use);
- to provide you with information about the Event;
- to correspond with you;
- to conduct the Event;
- to provide you with information after the Event
- to publish your name, surname, firm/company name and email in a booklet with your consent in accordance with Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 point (a) GDPR.

Data processing takes place upon your registration and is required for the purposes stated in Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 point (f) GDPR for the appropriate processing of your registration and the execution of the Event.

The personal data collected by us in this context will be stored until the end of the Event and deleted thereafter, unless you have consented to further storage in accordance with Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 point (a) GDPR, or we are entitled or obliged to store your personal data for other reasons.
